Davis, I DO HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE to have enlisted this Fifth day of August, 1864, to serve as a **Soldier** in the **Army of the United States of America**, for the period of ~~Two~~ Two YEARS, unless sooner discharged by proper authority: I do also agree to accept such bounty, pay, rations, and clothing, as are, or may be, established by law for soldiers. And I do solemnly swear that I will bear true and faithful allegiance to the **United States of America**; that I will serve them honestly and faithfully against all their enemies or opposers whomsoever; and that I will observe and obey the orders of the President of the United States, and the orders of the Officers appointed over me, according to the Rules and Articles of War.
