Sir:

I have the honor to transmit herewith
the Commission as 2^d Lt. of Philip C. Bier, and
also his Muster-in Paper. This Muster-in was
made on Feb. 8, 1863. I also transmit the Blank
Discharge paper. Gen. Orders No. 48, Current Series from
the War Department, paragraph 11th of Section
VIII provides that no enlisted man shall be
mustered as an officer until he has
been discharged as an enlisted man.
This Muster-in having been made on
Feb. 8, 1863 and the order being dated
Feb. 25, 1863, said order does not govern
this case, and did not govern the
musterings of Officers.
